Arja Karivieri is Viktor Rydberg Professor in Classical Archaeology and Ancient history at the Department of Archaeology and Classical Studies at Stockholm University since 2012. Between 2003 and 2011 she acted as Associate professor and Assistant professor in Stockholm. Between 2000-2002 she was research fellow at the Swedish Institute at Rome. She has also been research fellow at the Academy of Finland 1989-1994 in the project "Ideological Change and Social Reality in Late Antiquity" and she is member of the Swedish Pompeii Project since 2000, responsible with Dr Renée Forsell for the publication of the House of L. Caecilius Iucundus.

Her publications include, among others, "The Athenian Lamp Industry in Late Antiquity" (1996), "Magic and syncretic religious culture in the East" (2010), "Creating contacts: trade and exchange along the Via Egnatia from the Roman to the Early Byzantine period" (2011), "Patrons and Viewers in Late Antique Greece - from houses and villas to Early Christian churches" (2012), and "Tradition and Renewal - The archaeology of magic and theurgy in Athens and Rome in Late Antiquity" (2015).

Karivieri is member of the boards of Swedish Institutes at Athens and Rome and member of the Publication committee for the Swedish Institutes at Athens and Rome.
