Çimen Günay-Erkol is assistant professor of Turkish Literature at Özyeğin University, Istanbul. She earned her Ph.D. degree from Department of Literary Studies at Leiden University in 2008. During 2006 -2008, Günay-Erkol has lived and worked as an independent researcher in Tokyo, Japan. Since 2008, she has been teaching Turkish Language and Literature courses at Özyeğin University. She is currently leading a research project on women writers of Turkey which is funded by TÜBİTAK and partially supported by ESF under the COST umbrella titled "Women Writers in History: Toward a New Understanding of European Literary Culture." Her husband Güray Erkol is associate professor of Physics at Özyeğin University and her son Ali Liber Erkol is a two-year-old drummer.
