Dr. Paul T. Levin is the founding Director of the Stockholm University Institute for Turkish Studies (SUITS). He is the author of *Turkey and the European Union: Christian and Secular Images of Islam* (NY: Palgrave Macmillan 2011) and has published various articles on international relations and public administration. Before assuming his position at SUITS,

Dr. Levin was a Senior Lecturer in International Relations (IR) at Stockholm University's Department of Economic History, where he taught courses on IR theory, conflict and security, nationalism and collective identity, and social science methodology. Between 2007 and 2010, he served as Program Director for Governance and Management Training at Stockholm University. Dr. Levin is a recurring guest lecturer at Oxford University's Programmes in Leadership and Public Policy. He has been a Visiting Scholar at the School of Government at Sun Yat-sen University, and has given invited lectures and conference presentations in the USA, China, Turkey, the UK, Iran, the Czech Republic, Finland and Sweden.

Dr. Levin received his Ph.D. in International Relations from the School of International Relations at the University of Southern California in 2007, and an M.A. in Political Science with a focus on comparative politics in 2001, also from USC.
