Dr.Rano Turaeva-Hoehne defended her PhD in 2010. The PhD research was financially and institutionally supported by two Max Planck Institutes namely Max Planck Institute of Social Anthropology, Conflict and Integration department in Germany and Max Planck Institute of Psycholinguistics in the Netherlands. The thesis deals with the communication strategies of identity politics applying such methods as the ethnography of communication, discourse analysis and some of the tools of cognitive anthropology. Among Dr. Turaeva's publications are articles on citizenship, language and identity and traditional singing of *Halpas* as well as conference papers on labour migrants, rhetoric and identification, power and policy.
