# Itinera ad Or<mark>ien</mark>tes: Correcting some prejudices about travel and trade along the Egnatian Way in the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> centuries

Federica A. BROILO is an Italian scholar nowadays working as Assistant Professor of History of Art at MardinArtuklu University, in Turkey. She had been granted with fellowships by international institutions such as the Oxford Barakat Trust, the New Europe College (Romania), the Max Van Berchem Foundation (Switzerland), the Getty Foundation and the Max Plank Institute. She got her Ph.D in Oriental Studies from Ca' Foscari University in Venice, Italy, where she worked as lecturer of Byzantine and Islamic Architectural History. She has worked as an UNESCO consultant for the protection of Cultural Heritage in South-Eastern European Countries and has enrolled in several international archaeological excavations and surveys in Italy and abroad. She is the author of several articles on fountains and rituals of ablutions in both Early Christian and Islamic context. She also works on travel literature, food history as well as on artistic encounters between Europe and the East.
