Drawing upon a multi-sited ethnography, this research will explore how medical migrations challenge or reinforce ways of understanding the different cultures of care, citizenship, identity, and belonging among the people who seek medical care across borders. The research knits multiple threads together: the motivations for patient mobility, the privatization and outsourcing of healthcare, continuity in care, the impact of class and migration backgrounds on medical migrations, the regulation of entitlements and compensation of healthcare expenses.
