GENERAL OBJECTIVES OF THE MEETING

Freemuse and network partners in Asia, the Americas, Africa and Europe will build on existing initiatives and experiences in analysing threats to artistic freedom and to improve and develop joint documentation, monitoring and advocacy, nationally, regionally and internationally.

The objectives are to strengthen collaborations by understanding the individual partners' current capacities, focus areas, and strengths as well as the multiple challenges they face.

Whereas Freemuse in the past has initiated and collaborated with partners on UN UPR submissions, the project also aims to sensitize partners in how their current work may qualify them to develop and prepare inputs as well as submissions to UNESCO's QP and the UN UPR mechanisms.

After several years of COVID travel restrictions the project will enable partners to meet physically and develop new partnerships as well as new strategies.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES OF THE MEETING

- Participants will share a common knowledge and understanding of challenges in documenting and monitoring artistic freedom violations.
- Participants will strengthen the capacities of their organisations.
- The participating organisations will strengthen their collaboration efforts in advocating artistic freedom nationally, regionally and globally
