What can tiles reveal?

The Pera Museum and The Swedish Research Institute are proud to present a artist talk with artist Burçak Bingöl and architect Gertrud Olsson, exploring cultural heritage in ceramics and identity. Moderated by art historian Seda Yörüker, it's part of the Souvenirs of the Future exhibit. Bingöl discusses her work in Istanbul since 2010, focusing on ceramics and their historical and geographical significance. Her exhibit, *Route Saz Yolu*, reinterprets a 16th-century çini panel, examining its Silk Road influences.

Drawing from her book titled *Den lilla skalan i den stora – kaklet i osmanska rum* [The small scale in the large: Tiles in Ottoman rooms] (currently only available in Swedish), Olsson delves into the history and significance of Ottoman tiles, highlighting their architectural importance and the interplay of different cultures in crafting these timeless pieces.
