4. Turkish Red Crescent

Soup, hot food, snack food and tea are distributed within the Mobile Kitchen. Mobile Kitchens contain food preparation and cooking units, as well as cooling and service section and the kitchens contain all the equipment of a modern kitchen.

7. **NuDay Syria**

NuDay is a non-profit organisation that provides humanitarian relief to people affected by the crisis in Syria. Founded in 2013, NuDay is headquartered in New Hampshire. Since the start of the Syrian Revolution, NuDay has shipped millions of dollars worth of clothes, medicine, and food to displaced families in Syria.

8. **Bridge to Türkiye Earthquake Relief Fund (BTF)**

On 6 February 2023 A massive 7.5 earthquake struck the southeastern part of Türkiye and was felt in multiple countries and also had a devastating impact on North Western Syria. Severe damage and many casualties have reported. Türkiye has requested immediate international assistance.

BTF's approach to alleviating the pain and suffering that we are al witnessing in Turkey is in three phases:

Phase 1: Provide immediate assistance with Food, Water, and Warmth;

Phase 2: Provide immediate assistance for Sheltering;

Phase 3 and 4: Provide well-being for Children's Health and Education.

BTF's current Local Partner for Phases 1 and 2 is AHBAP Association, a well-known, well-run, reputable, and trusted grassroots organisation in Türkiye. BTF has already wired \$50,000 to AHBAP within the first day of the earthquake, and an additional \$100,000 on the second day.

100% of the funds collected by BTF for earthquake relief will be disbursed to AHBAP and any other local worthy partners in the upcoming days.

13. Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS)

The Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) Foundation is a global medical relief organisation that is working on the front lines of crisis relief in Syria, in neighbouring countries, and beyond to save lives and alleviate suffering. SAMS proudly provides medical care and treatment to every patient in need.

They are currently focusing their efforts on responding to the 7.8 richter scale magnitude earthquake on 6 February 2023 that struck southern Türkiye near the Syrian border at

around 04:17 am local time. A second 7.5-magnitude earthquake hit at around 13:30 local time (10:30am). It was described as a “once in a hundred years” event.

In northwest Syria, which was heavily impacted, SAMS medical teams are reported that at least 197 people have been killed and 659 people have been injured at SAMS facilities alone. In the aftermath of the catastrophic earthquake, SAMS medical teams in northwest Syria are working around the clock and have treated at least 600 victims so far. They are working to treat many others injured and save as many lives as possible.

SAMS-supported hospitals and medical facilities are overwhelmed with patients filling the hallways, creating an immediate need for trauma supplies. They need our support to treat the injured and save as many lives as possible. SAMS supports at least 36 medical facilities in the affected region of northwest Syria as well as a regional office in Gaziantep, Türkiye, near the epicentre of the first quake.

SAMS is evacuating patients from hospitals and facilities, which have sustained severe damage to safer facilities, while also working closely with local partners in a coordinated emergency response.

As SAMS responds to this catastrophic earthquake, they are asking for support. Public donations will help them speedily get emergency aid to earthquake victims and save as many lives as possible. It will help them deliver life-saving medical care to those affected by this disaster.

15. Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF UK) - Doctors Without Borders

Following the powerful earthquakes that hit the south of Türkiye and northwest Syria on 6 February 2023, Médecins Sans Frontières / Doctors Without Borders (MSF), already supporting the population of northwest Syria, has mobilized its team along with local partners to respond to the increasing needs in the area.

In Idlib, in northern Syria, they are treating hundreds of injured patients at MSF supported hospitals.

They have deployed ambulances and dispatched extra staff to hard-hit healthcare facilities. MSF provided immediate support to 23 healthcare facilities across Idlib and Aleppo governorates by donating emergency medical kits and providing medical staff to reinforce their teams.

They remain in close contact with authorities in northwest Syria and southern Türkiye, ready to provide further support to people affected by the earthquake.

Most of MSF's donations are "unrestricted" and can be used wherever the need is greatest. The actions their teams are taking in Syria and Türkiye are funded by donations however small from the general public.

Thanks to the generosity of people donating to their general funds, they don't always need to launch an appeal when a humanitarian emergency happens and so far they have not launched a separate emergency fund. Unrestricted donations have given them valuable flexibility to respond to the humanitarian crisis in Türkiye and Syria, where especially in North West Syria they have a lot of people on the ground.

16. Syria Relief & Development (SRD)

They work to provide aid to Syrians affected by violence, poverty, hunger, displacement and now an awful natural disaster. The volatile situation in Syria has created a dire need for healthcare, protection, and shelter, among other basic necessities and this has been worsened by the awful earthquake. SRD works to meet these needs in Syria and neighbouring countries through comprehensive and integrated programs. It is uniquely placed due to this to respond to the humanitarian disaster caused by the earthquake.

The epicentre of the first was in Gaziantep, where SRD's Türkiye country office is based. SRD's first responders are on the ground and their 20 ambulances have been deployed to serve those critically injured. Several hospitals in the region have been impacted by the earthquake, including Jandaris Hospital.

As communities who have been responding to the crisis are now affected, they need financial support to continue delivering their life-saving services. Donations will support medical care, fuel for their ambulances, shelter and food desperately needed in the area.

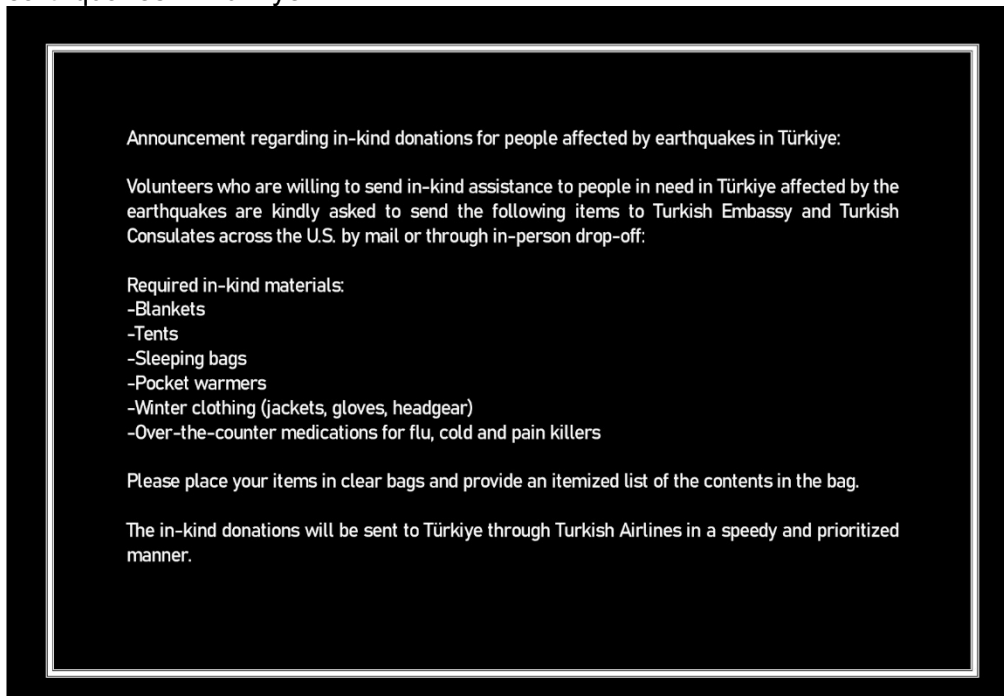

Ernesto's Sanctuary for Cats is an animal sanctuary currently based in Idlib, Syria. It was founded by Mohammad Aljaleel, who was dubbed the "cat man of Aleppo." Previously, Aljaleel had run a sanctuary in Aleppo where he cared for over a thousand cats. When the city fell to Syrian government forces though, he was forced to move on.

According to the BBC, the team ran animal welfare courses to develop empathy in local children and set up a playground next to the sanctuary to escape the ongoing civil war, even at its most extreme.

In 2016, the original sanctuary was reportedly bombed and chlorine-gassed during the siege of Aleppo. Aljaleel managed to make it back to Syria after escaping to Türkiye and set up a whole new cat sanctuary. Established in Kafr Naha, it now includes an orphanage, a kindergarten and a free veterinary clinic.

In response to the earthquakes in Türkiye and Syria looking for animals injured by the earthquake. Many are injured, mostly in shock, they don't even eat. They are asking for donations to the sanctuary, to help them save as many animals as they can.
