

KUDAR – SRII JOINT FELLOWSHIP

KOÇ UNIVERSITY MUSTAFA V. KOÇ MARITIME ARCHAEOLOGY RESEARCH CENTER (**KUDAR**) AND THE SWEDISH RESEARCH INSTITUTE IN ISTANBUL (**SRII**) WILL GRANT A SHORT-TERM FELLOWSHIP FOCUSING ON CONNECTIONS BETWEEN THE BYZANTINE AND NORDIC WORLDS

Description

This joint fellowship supports a PhD candidate or Post-Doctoral Researcher that will build upon the results of the recent digital exhibition “Nordic Tales, Byzantine Paths”. The successful candidate will be expected to prepare a related workshop, assist, and work on expanding the exhibition site, and take part in discussions for a graduate course planned in collaboration between Koç and Swedish Universities.

Fellowship will include a monthly stipend, insurance, and free housing at the guesthouse of SRII. It will be for two months (with the possibility of short extension), and the expected starting date is in April 2023. Depending on the circumstances, the fellowship may begin online for a certain period, during which the stipend will be paid. The fellow will have access to the libraries and research facilities of both Koç University and the SRII.

Preferences

The study and working language of Koç University is English. Knowledge of any Scandinavian language is an asset, and particularly an interest in the maritime connections between the Baltic and the Black Seas, digital humanities, and exhibitions as well as team spirit.
